

- 1. <u>**Do not**</u> ship live insects or arthropods. Crushed insects and insects stuck to clear tape are unidentifiable. Place insects in freezer to kill them. Preserve soft-bodied insects in a leak-proof vial of alcohol.
- For suspected bed bugs, <u>please email ladybug@uconn.edu</u> with an image of the insect before shipping.
- 3. Place the entire sample into a **sealed plastic bag**.
- 4. Ship in a **box** to avoid damaging the sample during transit. Insects will be crushed by mail machines if sent in a plain envelope.
- 5. Do not ship over a weekend or holiday to limit the time the sample is in transit.
